## **CA&E 458** Wants to Roll Again

Chicago Aurora and Elgin #458 was one of ten cars built for the CA&E by the St. Louis Car Co. and delivered in 1945. This was the last order of heavyweight interurban cars built in America. The Elgin Branch of the CA&E served South Elgin



through its Clintonville station whisking commuters to Chicago. The car was acquired by Trolleyville USA for operation at its museum. The Fox River Trolley Museum acquired #458 in 2009, bringing it back home. The story however does not end there. This car was purchased and transported to the museum at great cost and requires additional funding for painting, electrical and mechanical work as well as seating rehabilitation.
